

OPPOSITE DAY ROSÉ OF RRV PINOT NOIR 2019

TASTING NOTES: Our Pinot Noir Rosé has perfect soft delicate color, we call Ballerina Slipper Pink. The aromas show lime, bright cherry, strawberry and quince with a hint of orange blossom. The wine is fresh and firm on the palate giving lingering zest, delicate rhubarb and strawberry with a delightful crisp finish. Pair with fresh fish, poultry, cheeses, appetizers and snacks. If you are a pushover for the **PINK** stuff like we are, then enjoy it year-round. Step outside the box, break the rules, and embrace your **PINK** side because... It's not Red. It's not White. It's **OPPOSITE DAY**. I Dare You.



WINE DATA:

- **Vineyards:** Pinot Noir for our wine was grown in two vineyards: Stoney Point Road in the heart of Russian River Valley and Burnside Road in Russian River's Green Valley. Both vineyards are excellent cold climate Pinot Noir sites. 2019 was an ideal vintage with fresh forward fruit flavors.
- **Harvest:** September 2019 23.2° Brix
- **Winemaking:** Fruit was crushed to press to allow skin contact and color extraction (45 min). Pressed at 0.4 bar. Fresh juice was stainless steel tank fermented using a long cold fermenting yeast, VL3 at 55°. No ML fermentation was conducted.
- **Cooperage and Aging:** 100% Stainless Steel Tank, 30 day Ferment
- **Bottling:** Galentines Day February 13, 2020. 190 cases produced. Released February 20, 2020
- **Final bottling technical information:**
 - pH 3.454
 - TA 0.55 g/100 ml (5.5 g/L)
 - Alcohol 14.1 %
 - RS 1.07 g/L
